



Using Tiered Assessments

Providing Tiered Questions for each Objective

0 Three levels:

0 Type 1/Basic Items: *Address basic details and processes (Marzano)*

0 Bloom's Levels: Knowledge, Comprehension

0 Examples: Vocab, Recalling details, Basic skill necessary for mastery of objectives

0 Type 2/Target Items: *Address more complex ideas and processes (Marzano)*

0 Bloom's Levels: Application, Analysis

0 Examples: The targeted skill, Applying skill in context, Word Problems, Short answers, Explanations

Providing Tiered Questions for each Objective (cont.)

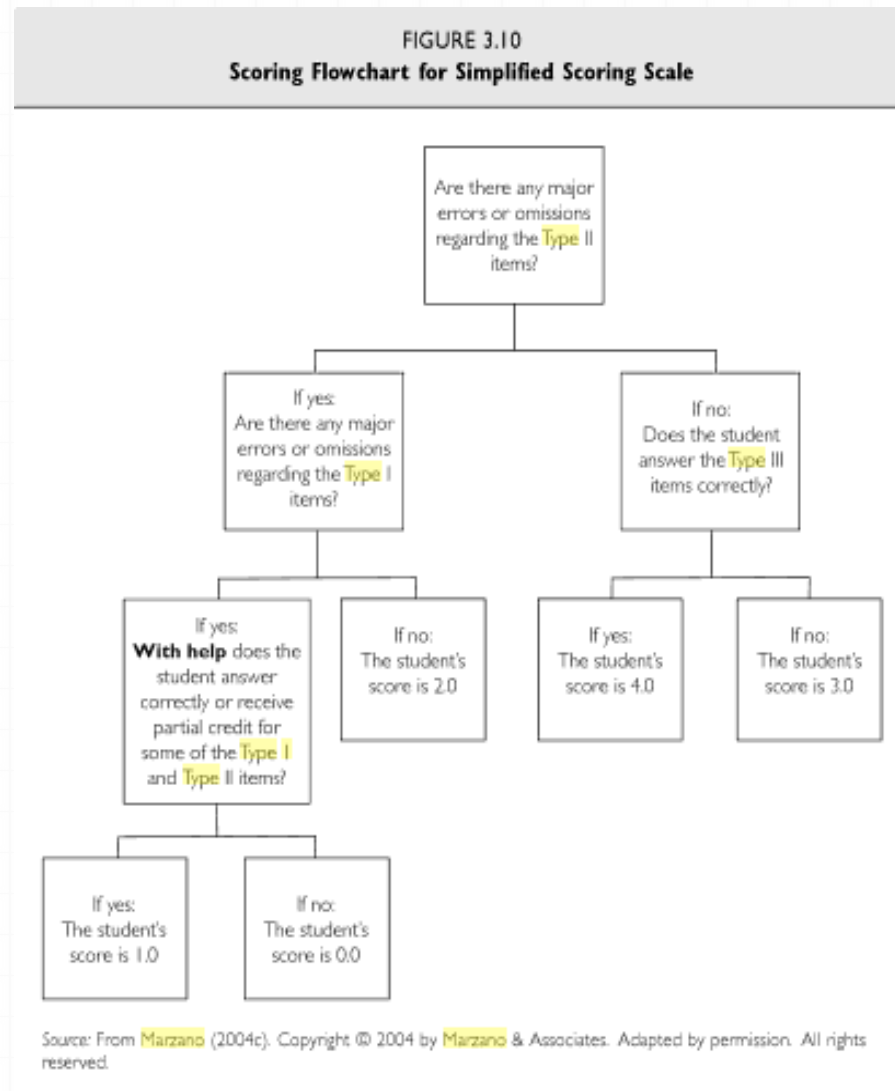
- 0 Three levels (cont.)

- 0 Type 3/Advanced Items: *Go beyond what was explicitly taught in class (Marzano)*

- 0 Bloom's levels: Synthesis, Evaluation

- 0 Examples: Extension projects/explorations, Questions/problems/prompts that require students to extend learning

Using Tiered Assessment to Grade with 4 point scale



Benefits of Using Tiered Assessments

- 0 Streamlines grading process along the 4 point scale
- 0 Allows for more specific feedback to students on their level of understanding
- 0 Streamlines student studying/re-take process
